

Pavement Decal Installation Instructions

- 1. Remove loose debris from designated area. The surface should be clean, dry and oil-free. Surface temperature must be above 50°F for best adhesion.
- 2. Mark the perimeter of the application surface with a chalk-line or other temporary marking.
- 3. Starting at top left corner, peel 6 to 8" of the back liner away from the decal.
- 4. Position the graphic using your temporary guides and apply exposed corner to surface.
 - 4a. Gradually peel back the remaining liner while simultaneously applying the rest of the decal. Press and smooth out decal as it is being applied to surface.
- 5. Starting in the center and working towards the edges; use a roller or your hand to thoroughly press the graphic onto the surface. Ensure the edges are sealed and that pavement decal fully adheres to any cracks or textures.
